joining Auckland **Council**.



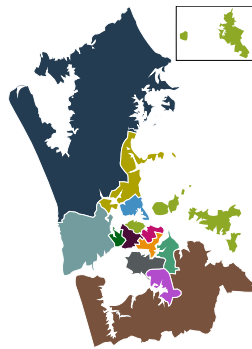
Auckland Council is a group
